## Guest Speaker: Tony Ransom introduced our guest speaker: Bob Crosby – speaking about Early Earthquake Warning for BC

Bob is a Software Quality Control Specialist at Ocean Networks Canada (ONC) and helped to develop their earthquake warning project. He explained the NEPTUNE network which is currently the largest and most complex wired undersea observatory network in the world. The history of earthquakes in our area was outlined and the possibility of a damaging earthquake for Southern Vancouver Island being a 1 in 3 chance in the next 50 years. He shared some information regarding how sensors can detect the start of an earthquake and given the short amount of time what can be done when that warning is received especially by industry connecting their computers. Earthquake safety tips were also reviewed. Such important information was well received by the membership with lots of questions and answers.
